## Yom Kippur Memorial Book

The Memorial Book is a long-standing tradition, honoring the memory of departed relatives and friends. It serves as a meaningful symbol of enduring faith and remembrance for each of our members. In order to ensure that the Memorial Book is ready for distribution prior to Yizkor services on Yom Kippur, the information must be received in the temple office not later than Sept. 4, 2009.

The Memorial Book will include a section listing those loved ones who have passed away since the printing of last year's Memorial Book. Another section will list those whose names appear on the congregation's memorial boards.

Any name, including those in the sections identified above, may be memorialized by request, for a *standard chai contribution of \$18 per name*. If you would like the names of your loved ones included, complete this form, and kindly return it with your gift to the Temple office. If you honored your loved ones in last year's Memorial Book, your listing is included below, for those who would like to include the same names as in the past. (If you wish to arrange a perpetual remembrance by purchasing a memorial plaque, please let us know this as well.)
